- Recruit, train, and develop a team of volunteers to create and conduct weekly Early Childhood services and activities that are biblically accurate, culturally relevant, and engaging for Early Childhood Kids.
- Develop and disciple a core volunteer leadership team to ensure high-level, reproducing leaders.



- Lead volunteers to create an Early Childhood environment that maintains the highest possible standards for infant and toddler safety and care.
- Work with the Kids team to brainstorm and ideate the direction of the Kids Ministry as a whole.
- Partner with parents to create opportunities for them to be actively involved in the spiritual development of their children.
- Assist in the development of the annual Early Childhood ministry budget and manage spending to budget throughout the year.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- College degree preferred.
- 3+ years of ministry experience as a staff member or volunteer.
- Able to lead and influence people to collectively meet deadlines while managing multiple projects.
- Strong influencing, communication, and presentation skills.
- Must be a proactive self-starter, creative problem solver and team player.
- Able to work collaboratively with other department teams to support the ministry of Southwest Church.
- Understanding of confidentiality and proper care of personal information.
- Knowledge of computer applications such as Word and/or Pages, Excel and/or Numbers, PowerPoint and/or Keynote, etc.
